For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion,
it is hereby

ORDERED that Judicial Watch’s Motion for Permission to Depose
Hillary Clinton, Clarence Finney, and John Bentel is **GRANTED IN
PART** and **DENIED IN PART**; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the State Department shall release all
remaining documents responsive to Judicial Watch’s Freedom of
Information Act request by no later than September 30, 2016; and
it is

FURTHER ORDERED that, consistent with Rule 33 of the Federal
Rules of Civil Procedure, Judicial Watch may serve
interrogatories on Secretary Clinton by no later than October
14, 2016; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that, consistent with Rule 33 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Secretary Clinton's responses are due by no later than thirty days thereafter; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Judicial Watch may not depose Mr. Finney; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Judicial Watch may depose Mr. Bentel by no later than October 31, 2016; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall submit a joint proposal for further proceedings in this case by no later than November 30, 2016.
