Methodology




Protestant, senior and executive pastors from Barna Group's Church Panel Total sample size, n=434

Each week, minimal weighting is used to ensure the data set is nationally representative based on region, church size, and denomination.




How is your family doing today?






How are the people in your church doing today?




Last week, how did online participation compare to typical (in person) Sunday attendance?








What happened with financial giving last weekend?






In the next week, what will work look like for your staff?











Currently, what do you see happening with congregants' personal faith journey during this pandemic?






As of today, when do think you'll be able to host church services again in your usual building / location(s)?




Based on everything you're seeing right now, how confident are you that your church will survive?





Which of the following describes your staffing decisions in the last week?






