7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Concurrent Resolution relating to the recognition
9 of the Day of Tears; encouraging Oklahomans to mourn
10 lives lost to abortion in Oklahoma; directing flags
11 to be flown at half-staff; and providing for
12 distribution.

13 WHEREAS, to recognize January 22, 2022, as the Day of Tears in
14 Oklahoma and to encourage Oklahoma citizens to lower their flags to
15 half-staff to mourn the innocent, preborn children who have lost
16 their lives due to abortion; and

17 WHEREAS, on January 22, 1973, the majority of the members of the
18 United States Supreme Court erroneously ruled that abortion was a
19 right secured by the Constitution of the United States of America;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, since that ill-fated day, over sixty-one million
22 (61,000,000) preborn children in the United States have perished.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
24 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
 CONCURRING THEREIN:

1 THAT the Legislature of Oklahoma does hereby recognize January
2 22, 2022, as the Day of Tears in Oklahoma and encourages Oklahoma
3 citizens to lower their flags to half-staff to mourn the innocent,
4 preborn children who have lost their lives due to abortion.

5 THAT a copy of this resolution be transmitted to Anne
6 Fitzgerald, executive director of Day of Tears.
